Governor Evers has ordered that all Wisconsin schools, public and private, are closed Wednesday, March 18th through Monday, April 6th. In accordance with his executive order, we will be closing schools on those dates.

We will also be out of school April 6th through 10th when we have our scheduled spring break. School will resume on Monday, April 13th unless another executive order requires additional measures.

School will be open Monday and Tuesday next week. While school is open, it is your decision as a parent whether you decide you want your child to attend school on these dates. We will be restricting our programming to essential academic functions only so all club activities, sports practices, and community meetings scheduled in our buildings will be cancelled on the 16th and 17th. We will be providing additional information by email over the weekend so we are encouraging you to check your email at least daily the next few days.

We realize that some schools are closing on Monday, but we want to give as much time as possible for families to figure out childcare and other family schedules during this period of school closure. That is why we are holding firm to the Governor's timeline.

Thank you for your patience during this turbulent time and pay careful attention to your health and the health of others.
