

What is the Integrated Business Management and Operations Pathway?

The Business Pathway refers to career fields related to money management.

This includes programs of study on subjects such as:

- Financial services, including banking and accounting-related services, financial and investment planning, and insurance services.
- Advertising, public relations, sales and planning marketing activities to reach organizational objectives.
- Planning, organizing, directing and evaluating business functions essential to efficient and productive business operations
- Providing support for computer hardware or software, designing new computer equipment, and contributing to the creation or development of video games.
- Emergency and fire management, law enforcement, legal services, correction services, security and protective services.
- Overseeing air, rail, road, and water travel logistics, managing large storage centers, and planning and revising schedules and plans related to transportation.
