HOW WE GOT HERE

District Facilities Committee

- o 14 members; 12+ plus meetings
- Started working February 2018
- Toured all district buildings
- o Toured Berlin, Brown Deer, Port Washington & Ripon Districts
- Surveyed committee members on directions to proceed with the High School options
- Made recommendations to board June 2019

Elementary Consolidation Committee

- o 20 members
- Started working November 2018
- o Made recommendations to board May 2019

Both Committees Recommended Reducing to 4 Buildings

District Facilities Committee Explored 17 Different Options Impacting All Schools

- o From doing nothing to replacing the high school on a TBD site
- Looked at short and long-term solutions
- Focused on maximizing existing buildings and sites
- Narrowed solutions address the most needs with the tax tolerance they felt the community might support
- Narrowed to 5 solutions

EXISTING HIGH SCHOOL - MAINTENANCE NEEDS

- Poor construction of original foundations
- Electrical wiring is not up to code
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance issues
- Cafeteria is undersized and inefficient
- Water infiltration issues
- Building lacks flexible areas for small and large group instruction and student collaboration
- Technical education (shop) area lacks space and equipment
- Secure entrances


Monroe School District Historical Mill Rate



PROPOSED OPTION 1 CONFIGURATION

- Abe Lincoln would be closed
- Parkside and Northside would be reconfigured to PK-3 buildings
- Middle School would become a 4-6 Intermediate School
 - Improve music rooms, science labs & increase gym space for students in grades 4 and 5 compared to current facilities
- High School would be remodeled in combination with new construction to create a 7-12 building
 - o 2 schools under 1 roof
 - Separate entrances and offices
 - o Renovate 144,500 sq. ft. and add 227,000 sq. ft.
 - Specialty areas used by all grades
- Project cost of \$86 Million (estimate)


OPTION 1 – CONCEPTUAL DRAWING



PROPOSED OPTION 5 CONFIGURATION

- Abe Lincoln would continue to operate as a 4K-5 school
 - o Updates and renovations
- Parkside would continue to operate as a K-5 school
- Northside would continue to operate as a K-5 school
- Middle School would continue to operate as a 6-8 school
- High School would be remodeled in combination with new construction to create a 9-12 building
 - o Renovate 147,500 sq. ft. and add 191,600 sq. ft.
- Project cost of \$81 Million (estimate)


OPTION 5 – CONCEPTUAL DRAWING



PROPOSED OPTION 3 CONFIGURATION

- Abe Lincoln would continue to operate as a 4K-5 school
 - o Updates and renovations
- Parkside would continue to operate as a K-5 school
- Northside would continue to operate as a K-5 school
- Middle School would continue to operate as a 6-8 school
- New High School constructed at a new site to create a 9-12 building
 - o New 264,600 sq. ft. High School
 - Close existing High School
- Project cost of \$88 Million (estimate)
- There is no image of the building because it could be designed in a variety of ways and we do not have land selected or surveyed yet

ABE LINCOLN ELEMENTARY – URGENT & 2-5 YEARS MAINTENANCE LIST

General Building Issues

- · Building envelope repairs
- Replace settling concrete & deteriorated asphalt
- Repair exterior wall leaks
- Repair foundation waterproofing & drain tile

Roof Issues

- Roof is in good condition
- Seal chimney

Fire Protection Issues

 No sprinklers included (Major additions may require adding sprinklers)

Plumbing Issues

- Add larger domestic water heater
- Add valves to domestic water piping

Mechanical Issues

- Replace original air handlers
- Replace original hot water/chilled water unit vents
- Provide separate HVAC unit for front office
- Replace the pumps
- · Update to digital controls
- · Duct cleaning & re-balance the building


Electrical Issues

- · Replace original electrical service
- · Add more electrical outlets
- Replace & expand data cabling
- Add new LED lighting
- · Allowance for ground wiring


Potential Remodel & Improvements

- Secure entrance
- · Classroom floors, ceilings and cabinetry replacement
- Gym floor replacement
- Updates to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Collaborative & flexible classrooms


