WHAT IS REGISTRATION AT MONROE MIDDLE SCHOOL?

Registration is <u>completed entirely online</u> beginning August 10th using your parent access through Skyward. School fees can be paid online through the Fee Management tab on Skyward. <u>Please be sure to update phone</u> <u>numbers and addresses on file as it is extremely important.</u>

ASSISTANCE WITH REGISTRATION

If you need access to a computer or assistance with the online registration, the office staff will be available August $17^{th} - 19^{th}$. There will be computers available to complete the online registration. MMS staff will assist you with online registration while practicing social distancing. <u>Masks will be REQUIRED to enter the building.</u> Any paperwork can be turned in at that time or sent in with your student on the first day of school. BACK TO SCHOOL INFORMATION

- **STUDENT SCHEDULES AND HOMEROOM ASSIGNMENTS:** Student Schedules will be available through parent or student access in Skyward. All students will receive a copy of their schedule on the first day of school from their Homeroom teacher.
- LOCKERS: Students <u>will not</u> be using lockers for the 2020-2021 school year.
- **STUDENT HEALTH:** If you have student health concerns, need to turn in any medications or medical forms, please call the office at (608)328-7120 to set up a time to do so.
- **FEE COLLECTION:** Fees can be paid online by logging into Family Access and selecting Fee Management. If you need assistance with the online payment, you can do this on one of the computers that will be set up in the office during the week of August 17th.
 - Using the online payment, you will be able to pay all current year school fees as well as any fees that may still be due from prior years. You will also be able to pay participation fees (\$25.00 each) for Volleyball, Cross Country and The Play/Musical (Please do not pay any participation fees online at this time due to activities/sports being TBD.)

- Payments via cash or check: Payments will be accepted in the MS office starting Monday, August 10th from 7am-3:00pm (Monday-Thursday) or sent in with your student the first week of school.
- FOOD SERVICE: Check account balances online and make deposits into your family account. Deposits into your lunch account are made online as an electronic withdrawal from your checking account or by credit/debit card
 Free & Reduced Lunch; If you did <u>NOT</u> receive a letter from the District Office stating that you

qualify for Free Lunch and you feel that you are eligible for Reduced or Free Lunch, please complete the Free & Reduced Lunch Application included in this packet and return it to the Middle School or District Office.

- **PHY ED NEW GUIDELINES:** Students will <u>not</u> be changing for Phy Ed during the 2020-2021 school year. Please be mindful on which day you have Phy Ed and wear comfortable clothing and non-marking athletic shoes to school that day to participate in Phy Ed. Students will no longer be using Phy Ed shirts.
- SPORTS, FINE ARTS, CLUBS AND ACTIVITIES (TBD): There are many activities available for Middle School Students to participate in. These activities include (but are not limited to) Wrestling, Boys & Girls Cross Country, Boys & Girls Track, Boys & Girls Basketball, Girls Volleyball, Play, Musical, Junior Optimists, Builders Club, Visioneers, Student Council, Math Club, Science Olympiads, Club Courage, Anime Club, Chess Club, Forensics, Nerd Squad, Yearbook & YANA club. *Details whether activities will be held for the 20-21 school year is TBD based on Covid details*
- LIFETOUCH PHOTOGRAPHY: School picture days will be September 15th & September 22nd. Retakes will be November 3rd & November 10th. All students will receive a student I.D. card. (*Purchasing photographs is completely optional and <u>checks for purchases should be payable to</u> <u>LIFETOUCH</u>.) Please remember that checks for School Pictures should be payable to Lifetouch.*
- SPORTS: *Details whether sports will be held for the 20-21 school year is TBD based on Covid details*
- Masks: <u>WILL BE</u> required during the 2020-2021 school year. If students refuse to wear their masks, review the following:

<u>1st Offense</u> - Student will be sent home for the remainder of the day with a written notice of the violation.

<u>2nd Offense</u> - Student will be placed in district virtual Programming (Plan H) for the remainder of the grading period (semesters in elementary and middle school, trimesters in high school)
